Experience life as a shepherd in the Wild West from the 1800's when you stay in this sheep wagon!

> Comfortable sleeping arrangement for 4

Bring your own bedding

1 short full size bed (can fit up to 2 adults) 2 cot size mattress beds (for adults or children)

- Storage is limited in this wagon. Pack light or storing gear in your vehicle.
- A bin is provided outside sheep wagon to for shoes to keep space clean.
- The wagon has a power strip for your electronic needs.
- A light, a lamp, a lantern, and a nightlight are provided.
- There is a short and lit-up path to the bathroom nearby



Has air conditioning and a heater for a comfortable night stay!

This YURT TENT is glamping at it's best!

Comfortable sleeping arrangement for 6

Note: could squeeze up to 8 if necessary

Bring your own bedding 1 queen size bed (can fit up to 2 adults and a little one in the middle) 2 cot bunks (sleeps 4 kids or adults) 1 portable mattress pad (for a child) to sleep on the ground or bring your own pack-n-play)

- Storage is adequate for 6 people but tight with 8. Consider packing light or storing your gear in your vehicle A bin is provided outside to keep shoes in to keep things clean

- The yurt has a power strip for your electrical needs A light, a lamp, a lantern, and a nightlight are provided There is a short and lit-up path to the bathroom nearby

Has air conditioning and a heater for a comfortable night stay!

Damages & Cleaning

Get in touch with us if there is anything damaged. By welcoming you to the farm, we ask that you please help us to respect and care for the buildings, grounds, and animals. Guests who incur damage to the property of Lumen Christi Farm are responsible for recovering the cost of that damage. This amount will be determined based on each situation. We ask that you help to keep our overnight accomadations clean and leave your spaces the same as you found them!

Payment

Reservations and payments for our sheep wagon and yurt tents are made online

Cancellation Policy

We can offer a full refund for cancellations 7+ days out, 50% refund for cancellations 4-7 days out, and no refund for cancellations within 4 days. If cancellations need to be made due to extreme weather conditions or circumstances on our part, you will be notified and a full refunds will be issued.

Important Info.

We are a no-smoking/no alcohol/no drugs facility

To ensure the health and safety of our animals and our guests, there is absolutely no feeding our cats or farm animals without the approval or supervision of staff or volunteers

Guests and visitors should keep noise at a minimum between 9 pm to 8 am as a courtesy to the other guests

Cell Phones and WIFI: We encourage you to put away your phones and truly be present to God and each other when you are at Lumen Christi Farm. We do not have free WIFI. We do have a landline phone if you need to use it for emergencies.

Modest Dress: Please dress appropriately for our Christian environment. No short shorts/skirts, no profane t-shirt messages, no low cut shirts or bellies showing please

Food and Kitchen

Bring your own food and plates/cups/eating utensils

Your stay includes the shared use of our community kitchen (Blessed Maria's Kitchen)

The Kitchen has the following for you to use: sink commercial refrigerator, coffee hutch with coffee maker/Keurig, microwave, stove, toaster oven, outdoor gas grill, towels/washcloths, cooking/serving utensils/knives/pots and pans/baking sheets/large bowls and casserole dishes

*Please make sure you clean up after yourselves





In order to keep things clean and critters out, we ask that NO food be brought into the Yurt tent and sheep wagons. Food needs to be prepared in our kitchen, by the fire pit, or using our gas grill.

Each unit will receive a 27 gallon tote bin for dry goods storage and a bin for refrigerated items in our commercial refrigerator. You can also keep things in your vehicle.
